Remembering Charlie Brown

It was with great sadness that the Society announced the sudden passing of *President Charlie Brown* on August 9, 2021. Charlie was unable to recover from a severe injury he suffered two days earlier while doing one of the things he loved best - "house-sitting" during a wedding at his beloved Oakland House.

According to Nancy Herndon Ulrich, who knew him since 1968, Charlie first came to Oakland for the July 4th Celebration in 1989. He and his wife Barbara joined that very day and became regulars. Over the years, they worked every event, and Charlie joyfully took on the



duties of Director, Vice President, and then President. Charlie was a kind and generous man, with a keen mind and wonderful sense of humor. He loved biographies, road trips and dressing Victorian. He attended every wedding at Oakland while President, always willing to lend a hand. He was a party man, a gentleman, a detail man and a golfer. Charlie hasn't really left us, but has moved to his final resting place on the hill, overlooking his beloved Oakland, still on Louie's land.

Our sympathies, thoughts and prayers are with Charlie's family and many friends. He is greatly missed.

FINALLY SHUTTERS!! Our shutter project was set in motion about 18 months ago and we are now proud to show off three sides of Oakland with really beautiful reproduction copies of the originals, in the basement and under the veranda roof. Our stunning shutters, complete with "shutter dogs" to hold them open, were masterfully crafted by Alexandre Mattan of Ambacht Woodworking of St. Louis. We had so many



windows and doors that required shutters that we ran out of space in his shop and our basement while the paint was curing... BUT, they were worth the wait.

Lemp's Last Wright Update: Unfortunately, the film premiere that had been scheduled for November 7 has now been postponed indefinitely. According to Executive Producer Frank Cambeletta, COVID protocols have forced the technicians to work from home, so they've been unable to come together to put the finishing touches on the film. Shift Films has kept a record of all ticket holders and will make notification when the film is finally complete sometime in 2022. Frank was saddened to learn of Charlie's passing and

commented on what a big help he'd been during production. Frank plans to place a memorial tribute to Charlie in the film's credits.
